Family Stories Month

Family Stories Month rolls around in November just in time for the holidays. When families gather it's an excellent time to share stories and learn about family history. Throughout the month Family History Month encourages you to record or listen to stories from relatives of all ages.

Prepare for Sharing and Preserving Family Stories

- Prepare a list of questions, or memory prompts to share with family members during family gatherings.
- Ask family to write their memories in story form to share. Offer to compile them in a book for family members as the family memoir.

How to celebrate family stories month

- **Tell a story.** Use the month to bond with your kids. Tell them stories related to your youth and how things were during that time.
- **Watch old home movies.** Watch old home movies with your family. This could include videos of your kids when they were young, as well as videos from your childhood.
- **Start a new tradition.** During the month, plan activities with your kids and start a tradition that can be repeated every year. The traditions you form will be a part of the stories they tell their own kids one day.
